



Guelph Lakes Golf Club Covid – 19 Operating Protocols 2021

UPDATED JULY 21st , 2021

Please take a moment to review and **understand** the following protocols that have been put into place at Guelph Lakes Golf Club to best provide a safe and healthy environment for our guests and staff. Please follow all protocols to ensure we are able to remain open during this difficult time.

Failing to comply with the following may result in removal from the property with no refund!

BEFORE YOUR ROUND / DAY OF PLAY

- If you are experiencing signs of COVID-19 please **do not** come to the course
- It is mandatory to book a tee time before heading to the course, you will not be paired with other players if you arrive without a tee time
- Please arrive to the course no sooner than **45** minutes prior to your tee time
- Face masks are **Mandatory** to enter the clubhouse as per Guelph Wellington Public Health (fine up to \$5000)
- **Enter** using the front proshop door (will be kept open weather permitting)
- **Check In** one person at a time keeping a distance of 2 metres apart, please use tap if available, outdoor check in will be available weather permitting
- **Exit** using the back door near the putting green (will be kept open weather permitting)
- No golf club rental available, please have your own clubs
- Until June 30th Power cart rental is single riders only unless 2 riders are from the same household or both riders have completed Covid vaccination
- As of July 1st Single rider carts will be available for an additional \$6 per player.
- Power carts will not be reserved, available on a first come first serve basis
- Power carts will be sanitized after each use
- Practice range will have a limited number of hitting areas and is open for golfers on the tee sheet that day and Driving Range Pass holders only (1 large bucket per day)
- Clubhouse washrooms are open and will be cleaned and sanitized on a regular basis
- **Limited food and beverage service available** (no on course beverage service it is closed for the season), please purchase drinks or snacks before your round or after 9 holes
- Indoor Dining will not be available this year, our full kitchen service will remain closed. The BBQ will be open on a day to day basis. We encourage you to support the many local restaurants that are now open again.



- Hand sanitizer stations will be located in proshop and washrooms
- High touch areas will be sanitized regularly
- **Arrive Prepared;** we encourage you to please bring your own hand sanitizer, wipes, face covering to use on the property
- Please bring your own bottled water and snacks with you

ON THE COURSE

- Be aware of and remain vigilant of mandatory physical distancing (**2 metres apart**)
- Tee times are spread out to allow physical distancing throughout the round (**10 min intervals**)
- A brisk pace of play of a **maximum of 4 hours** is required and will be enforced. Please help us avoid backups on the course
- Cups will be have a stopper to prevent the ball from reaching the bottom of the hole
- Flagsticks may be removed from the hole
- On course portable washrooms are now open
- Ball washers are now available
- Remember to practice physical distancing at all times (tee boxes, fairways, greens)
- If threatening weather approaches **do not gather in rain shelter or the clubhouse**, please return to your vehicles immediately
- Please wash your hands at the outdoor sink if entering the clubhouse after 9 holes



AFTER YOUR ROUND

- No handshakes or high fives
- Continue practicing physical distancing (2 metres apart)
- Please take your garbage with you
- Park power carts in the designated return area
- Patio is now open (maximum of 30 minutes seated per group)
- Limited food available – BBQ open on a day to day basis
- If you must re-enter the clubhouse please wash hands at outdoor sink before entering
- No socializing in the clubhouse or parking lot

Failure to comply may result in removal from property with no refund. Understand that following these protocols cannot GUARANTEE 100% safety. If you are vulnerable or uncomfortable in the current environment please stay home.
